




#### Black, Holly - The Prisoner's Throne: A Novel of Elfhame


#### Blackwood, Lauren – The Dangerous Ones




## Brown, Daniel James - Facing the Mountain: A True Story of Japanese American Heroes in World War II: Adapted for Young Readers



complicated history with Samantha. Despite deep mistrust, the four must now take matters into their own hands and clear their names. Even though one of them may be the murderer.




#### Cole, Olivia A. – Ariel Crashes a Train






