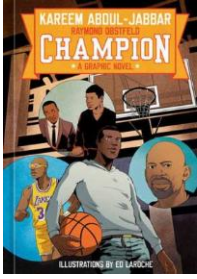


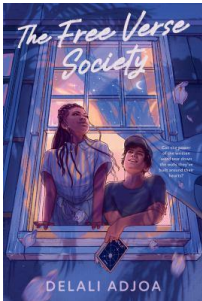

Abul-Jabbar, Kareem- Champion

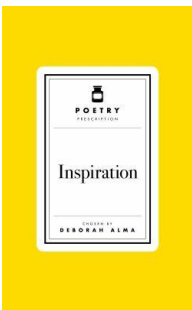

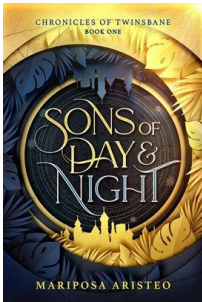
Adjoa, Delali- The Free Verse Society

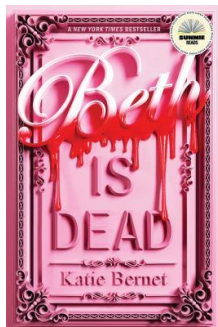


Barnes, Jennifer Lynn- Glorious Rivals

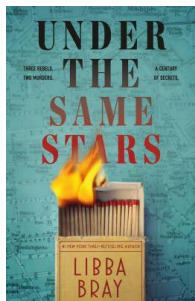


Bernet, Katie- Beth is Dead

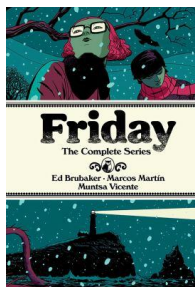


Bray, Libba- Under the Same Stars

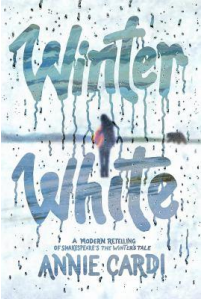


Brubaker, Ed- Friday: The Complete Series

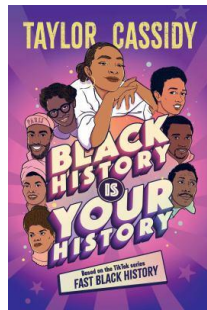

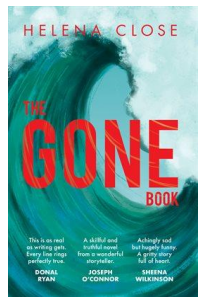


Cassidy, Taylor- Black History is Your History

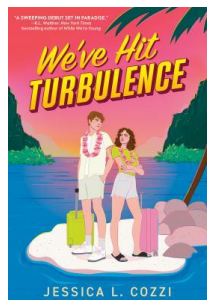


Close, Helena- The Gone Book

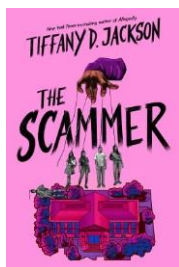


Ixta, Carolina- Few Blue Skies

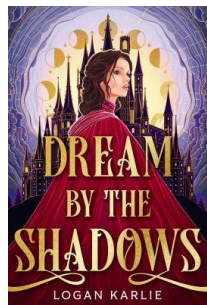

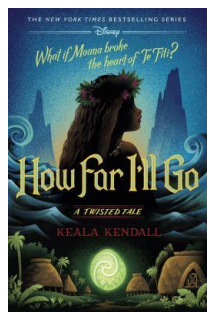


Karlie, Logan- Dream by the Shadows

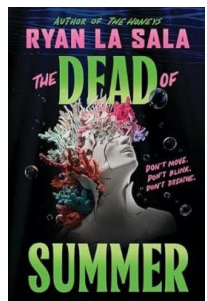


Kendall, Keala- How Far I'll Go

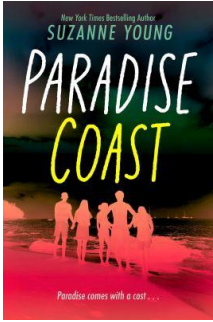


Young, Alexandra Leigh- Lou with the Band
