Brown, R. *Stranger*

Long ago, the Cataclysm struck, destroying governments and giving rise to the "Mutation", granting some people special powers. In the city of Las Anclas, Ross Juarez makes his living finding treasures from before to sell. But when he finds an ancient book he can't read, he ends up with a bounty hunter on his tail, ready to kill him and steal the book.

Carson, R. *Any Sign of Life*

Paige Miller fears she is the only person left alive in Ohio until she meets a handful of other survivors, and together they struggle with the knowledge that their new reality is the first part of an alien invasion.

Dimaline, C. *The Marrow Thieves*

In a future world devastated by climate change, people have lost the ability to dream, spreading insanity among the survivors. The only people still able to dream are North American Indigenous tribes, and their marrow can cure the world. But this means death for the marrow donors, and a group of teenagers must try to hide from marrow "recruiters", escape from marrow-stealing "factories" and reunite with their families in a ravaged world.

Gray, C. *Defy the Stars*

Noemi and Abel are enemies in an interstellar war, forced by chance to work together as they embark on a daring journey through the stars. Their efforts would end the fighting for good, but they're not without sacrifice. The stakes are even higher than either of them first realized, and the more time they spend together, the more they're forced to question everything they'd been taught was true.

Harrison, M. *The Glare*

Hedda was taught to be afraid that technology would get inside her mind. But now she's going to stay with her dad in California and she's ready to be normal. Once she arrives, Hedda finally feels like she's in control. Never mind the terrifying nightmares and visions that start trickling back -- they're not real. Then Hedda rediscovers the Glare: a first-person shooter game from the dark web that scared her when she was younger. They say if you die thirteen times on level thirteen, you die in real life...

Hirsch, J. *Unnatural Disasters*

Lucy Weaver has her future all figured out. But when everyone's phones start to ring halfway through prom, Lucy knows something terrible has happened. Decades of climate change have left the world teetering on the brink: entire cities drowned, violent extremism on the rise, millions of refugees with nowhere to turn. Is this the night it finally slips over the edge?

Hughes, N. *Refraction*

After an attack on earth, all reflective surfaces become weapons to release monsters, causing a planet-wide ban on mirrors. Despite the danger, 17-year-old Marty becomes a distributor in an illegal mirror trade until he is caught by the mayor's son. Both are exiled to one of the many abandoned cities overrun by fog. But they soon realize their thoughts influence their surroundings and their deepest fears begin to manifest.

Hutchinson, S. *We Are the Ants*

Henry Denton keeps getting abducted by aliens. But this time, they tell him the world will end in 144 days and all he has to do to stop it is push a big, red button. But Henry's not so sure he wants to -- after all, his life isn't that great since his boyfriend committed suicide last year. But as Henry starts to think about what's really good and bad in the world, his choice is coming ever closer...

Jones, G. *No True Echo*

Teenaged Eddie meets a new girl who is a Senior Echo Time Agent from the future, who comes to his town to investigate the origin of time travel. Soon Eddie is swept up in the investigation and in time. But time travel is a dangerous business, and Eddie will learn more than he wants to know about his long-dead mother.

King, A.S. *Switch*

Set in a parallel version of America where time has stopped, the novel tells the story of one teenage girl trying to untangle her toxic family's secrets--and maybe restart the world's clocks in the process.

Kirby, M. *Star Splitter*

Seventeen-year-old Jessica Mathers wakes up in a lander that's crashed onto the surface of Carver 1061c, a desolate planet fourteen light-years from Earth. The corridors of the empty lander are covered in bloody handprints; the machines are silent and

dark. And outside, in the alien dirt, there are fresh graves carefully marked with names she doesn't recognize. Now Jessica must unravel the mystery and the questionable intentions of a familiar stranger.

Klune, T. *The Extraordinaries*

Nick would rather write fanfiction about the feats of heroism and romantic entanglements he imagines for the very real superheroes who inhabit his city. When he meets Nova City's biggest hero (and his biggest crush), however, he resolves to become a superhero himself.

Kristoff, J. *Lifel1k3*

It's just another day on the Scrap: dodge the gangs and religious fanatics, discover you can destroy electronics with your mind, stumble upon the deadliest robot ever built. When Eve finds the ruins of an android boy named Ezekiel in the scrap pile she calls home, her entire world comes crashing down. With her best friend and her robotic sidekick in tow, she and Ezekiel will trek across deserts of irradiated glass, battle cyborg assassins, and scour abandoned megacities to save the ones she loves and learn the dark secrets of her past.

Lee, M. *Gamora & Nebula: Sisters in Arms*

The relationship between teenage adopted sisters Gamora and Nebula is as volatile as ever. When they end up on a deteriorating planet being mined for its valuable resources, the two sisters are faced with a series of events that force them to explore the source of their rivalry-and where their loyalty truly lies.

Lo, M. *Adaptation*

Birds are mysteriously flying into cars and planes, and millions of travelers are stranded. When Reese tries to return home, her car is flipped over by a bird and she wakes up in a military hospital, where no one will explain what happened. Once back home, a strange presence seems to be following her, and she must join forces with the beautiful Amber Gray to expose a global conspiracy kept secret for decades.

Lu, M. *Skyhunter*

Talin is a Striker, a member of an elite fighting force that stands as the last defense for the only free nation in the world: Mara. Talin knows firsthand the horrors of the Federation, a war machine responsible for destroying nation after nation with its terrifying army of mutant beasts

known as Ghosts. But when a mysterious prisoner is brought from the front to the capital, Talin senses there's more to him than meets the eye.

Lyga, B. *The Secret Sea*

Zak Killian hears a voice, one so real it warns him of danger and directs him to safety. Then one day the voice warns him to run. The tunnel starts to fill with water. His friends Moira and Khalid believe this is more than a premonition, and soon all three find themselves in an alternate universe that is both familiar and seriously strange. As Zak unravels the mystery behind the voice, he faces decisions that may mean the end of their world at home.

Mason, M. *Your Life Has Been Delayed*

Jenny Waters boards her flight in 1995, but when she lands, she and the other passengers are told they disappeared 25 years ago. Now Jenny must quickly adjust to smartphones and social media while being the biggest story to hit the internet. Will Jenny figure out how to move forward, or will she always be stuck in the past?

Oliver, B. *The Loop*

Luka Kane is wrongfully imprisoned inside the Loop awaiting his execution. Each day is the same. But things are starting to change. Whispers of war are circulating. Strange things are happening to the prisoners. Now Luka must decide whether breaking out of the Loop is his only way to survive, but the population on the outside may be far more terrifying than anything he could have imagined.

Rett Ward knows how to hide. But when he wakes up locked in a small depot with no memory of how he got there, he can't hide from the stranger in the next room, or from the blood on his jumpsuit. Worse, every time he tries to escape, he wakes up right back where he started. Segel, J. *Otherworld*

Otherworld is more than a game – it's addictive, a

whole other world that will make all your dreams come true. At least, that's what the company says. Simon discovers that Otherworld is really the next phase of reality, giving people everything they ever wanted and changing humanity forever.

Star Wars *Lost Stars*

Eight years after the fall of the Republic, the Empire reigns over the galaxy, and resistance has been all but silenced. Few aside from former Senator Bail Organa dare to openly oppose the Emperor. One by one, Outer Rim planets continue to fall. The latest is Jelucan, whose citizens continue to hope for a prosperous future even as the Imperial Starships loom overhead.

Star Wars *Leia, Princess of Alderaan*

But her parents are becoming secretive, and Leia starts to wonder if there is something bigger going on than her future role.
