LIBRARY BUDGET VOTE **TUESDAY, APRIL 16TH, 2013**

Residents of the Center Moriches Union Free School District are asked to vote on the Library's budget on Tuesday, April 16th, 2:00pm - 9:00pm in the Library's Community Room. A public hearing on the proposed Library budget will be held in the Community Room on Monday, April 8th at 7:00pm.

On Tuesday, April 9th, 2:00pm - 8:30pm, voter registration for residents of the Center Moriches Union Free School District will be held in a Library meeting room. Copies of the proposed budget for the Library's 2013-14 fiscal year will be available at the Circulation Desk one week before the voting date.

Residents of the contracting school districts East Moriches, Eastport-South Manor, and Remsenburg-Speonk will be asked to vote on their Library Proposition on Tuesday, May 21st at the polling places and times for their respective school district budget votes.

PLEASE NOTE! The Annual Library Proposition for East Moriches, Eastport-South Manor, and Remsenburg-Speonk is to determine whether residents of these contracting districts desire public library service to their communities for the upcoming fiscal year, from a choice of public libraries serving the respective districts. If you reside in one of these contracting districts, it is important that you vote on your Annual Library Proposition.

CENTER MORICHES LIBRARY RECEIVES 5-STAR RATING

For the fifth consecutive year, Center Moriches Free Public Library has received a prestigious American Star rating by Library Journal, the oldest and most respected publication covering the library field.

Library Journal's American Star ratings are based on a library's circulation per capita, visits per capita, program attendance per capita, and public Internet terminal uses per capita. In other words, the library is rated in accordance with how busy it is in relation to the population it serves.

7,570 public libraries across the nation were rated. Of these, 262 libraries received the honor of having been awarded at least one star. And out of these, 86 were award 5 stars. Center Moriches Free Public Library is one of the 86 public libraries in a field of 7,570 to have received the 5-star rating for services offered to the public.
