In *Brooklyn Boomer*, the author recalls his middle-class upbringing during the '50s alternating with chapters detailing the seminal cultural events of that era including; the popularization of television, fast-food, big cars with fins, desegregation and white flight to the suburbs, rock and roll, beatniks, hula hoops, the Cold War, McCarthyism, and much more.

Raised in Brooklyn, from his birth in 1946 until 1962, Mr. Levinson grew up two blocks from Ebbets Field and attended Erasmus Hall High School which boasts alums such as Neil Diamond, Barbra Streisand, and chess genius Bobby Fischer. Books will be available for purchase.
