LIBRARY BUDGET VOTE TUESDAY, APRIL 8TH, 2014.

Residents of the Center Moriches Union Free School District are asked to vote on the Library's budget on Tuesday, April 8th, 2:00pm-9:00pm in the Library's Community Room. A public hearing on the proposed Library budget will be held in the Community Room on Monday, March 31st at 7:00pm. Copies of the proposed budget for the Library's 2014-15 fiscal year will be available at the Circulation Desk two weeks before the voting date.

Residents of the contracting school districts East Moriches, Eastport-South Manor, and Remsenburg-Speonk will be asked to vote on their Library Proposition on Tuesday, May 20th at the polling places and times for their respective school district budget votes.

Please note! The Annual Library Proposition for East Moriches, Eastport-South Manor, and Remsenburg-Speonk is to determine whether residents of these contracting districts desire public library service to their communities for the upcoming fiscal year, from a choice of public libraries serving the respective districts. If you reside in one of these contracting districts, it is very important that you vote on your Annual Library Proposition.


