

REMEMBERING LEW BRUNNE FOR THE DEDICATION OF THE BRUNNEMER BOOK COLLECTION AUGUST 23RD, 12:00PM.

As a longtime popular English teacher at Center Moriches High School, Lew Brunnemer always spread his passion for reading. He wanted to make sure that carried on, and it will, with the Lewis A. Brunnemer Memorial Collection, which will be dedicated at the Center Moriches Public Library on Saturday, August 23.

In one of his final wishes, just before his death at age 60 in 2012, he donated a good portion of his vast book trove to the library, where it will be part of the permanent collection. Patrons will see a wide and eclectic assortment in a special display. Beginning at the dedication, the books will be available for circulation, which was also one of Mr. Brunnemer's requests.

The public is invited to join his family and friends and library staff for the event between 12 noon and 2 p.m. Refreshments will be served by the Friends of the Library as part of an occasion that will celebrate Mr. Brunnemer's life.

"I want people to remember Lew as an intellectually curious and joyous person," said his wife Terry, who moved to Center Moriches with Lew in 1975. "He was a great teacher who made a lasting impression on his students. People loved to be around Lew because he possessed a wealth of information on just about any subject and he was a lot of fun."

She said that aside from being "the most wonderful husband, father and grandfather... He could tell a great story and he could make a perfect martini!"

Their home, only a half-block from the library, was filled with books. Mrs. Brunnemer and several Center Moriches librarians perused them all and came up with a sampling that reflects the varied interests of a teacher who loved poetry, film, music, travel, politics, biking, hiking, cooking and Long Island history.

All of William Shakespeare's comedies and tragedies are in the library's new collection, as are several Shakespeare biographies. Among the other titles are Homer's "The Iliad," "The Poorhouse Fair" by John Updike, "Guys and Dolls" by Damon Runyon, "Poe: Poetry and Tales," "Middlemarch" by George Eliot, "Bluebeard" by Kurt Vonnegut, "The Odes of John Keats," "Going to Patchogue" by Thomas McGonigle and "The South Fork" by Everett T. Rattray.

Mrs. Brunnemer said Lew had an encyclopedic recall of all of his books and knew just where to look when he needed to look up something. His teaching wasn't limited to Center Moriches, he was an adjunct professor at Suffolk Community College.

His service wasn't limited to teaching. He was commodore of the Moriches Yacht Club and was vice-president of the Center Moriches Teachers Association, helping to negotiate contracts that he knew would be fair to both his fellow teachers and his fellow taxpayers.


The memorial collection will be one more, and lasting, contribution to his community.


