Copies of the proposed budget for the Library's 2014-15 fiscal year will be available at the Circulation Desk two weeks before the voting date.

Residents of the contracting school districts East Moriches, Eastport-South Manor, and Remsenburg-Speonk will be asked to vote on their Library Proposition on Tuesday, May 19th at the polling places and times for their respective school district budget votes.

Please note! The Annual Library Proposition for East Moriches, Eastport-South Manor, and Remsenburg-Speonk is to determine whether residents of these contracting districts desire public library service to their communities for the upcoming fiscal year, from a choice of public libraries serving the respective districts. If you reside in one of these contracting districts, it is very important that you vote on your Annual Library Proposition.

LINES TO REGISTER FORM BEFORE 9:30AM & NUMBERS ARE ASSIGNED AS PEOPLE ARRIVE.

Program registration for adults is generally held on Saturday mornings when the library opens. Although we open at 9:30am on Saturday, lines often start to form early for program registration. Numbers are handed out in the order that people arrive for registration, so that order may be maintained.

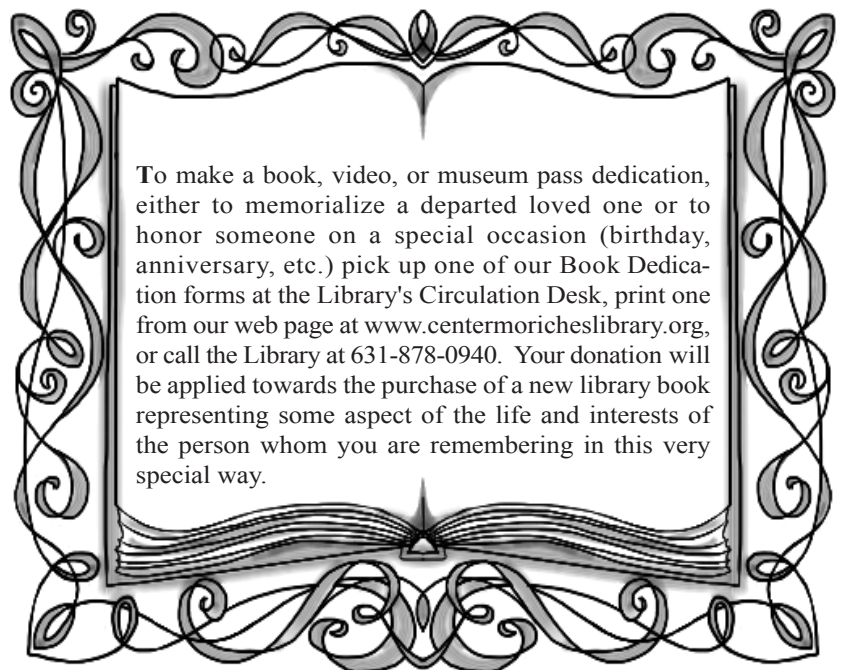
