WHAT TO DO WHEN IT'S TIME TO RENEW

YOUR LIBRARY CARD

- Residents of East Moriches, Manorville, Eastport, Remsenburg, and Speonk may join the Center Moriches Free Public Library.
- The first adult household member to register designates CMFPL as their entire household's home library for the contract year.
- Applicants must be 18 years and older, all others require a parent's signature.
- Acceptable single document IDs are: driver's license, state ID card, tax bill or deed. Otherwise, two IDs are required such as canceled mail or other official documents listing name and street address.
- Contract registrations expire annually on June 30th and may be renewed on or after July 1st.






