LIBRARY JOURNAL **LIBRARY** CENTER MORICHES FREE PUBLIC LIBRARY RECEIVES 5 STAR RATING BY LIBRARY JOURNAL FOR 4TH CONSECUTIVE YEAR!

The Center Moriches Library is among 6 libraries in Suffolk County to have received a Five Star rating from Library Journal, the oldest and most respected publication in the field. Of the 261 Star Libraries, only 84 have received a five star rating nationally. Library Journal star ratings are based on each library's number of annual patron visits, circulation, public access computer use, and program attendance. Star Library ratings of five, four, and three stars are awarded to libraries that generate the highest combined per capita outputs among their spending peers. This data is reported each year by public libraries to their state library agencies and is compiled on a national level by the Institute of Museum and Library Services.




