LEARN TO BE...TOBACCO FREE! (ATTENDALL SESSIONS) CMA730 TUESDAYS, JULY 11TH, 18TH, 25TH, AUGUST 1ST, 8TH & 15TH, 6:00-8:00PM. REUNION CLASS: AUGUST 29TH.

In this program sponsored by the Suffolk County Department of Health, you will learn there are hundreds of ingredients in a cigarette and when burned, thousands of toxic chemicals, hazardous to your health are created. Learn behavior modification techniques to help change habits associated with smoking as well as coping strategies, stress management and communication skills. After the 3rd week, smoking cessation medications including nicotine replacements Zyban or Chantix will be provided for an annual fee of \$50 to medically eligible participants. (This will be discussed on the first night of class. A nurse practitioner will dispense these medications in a separate, private area.) Class size is limited.

PROGRAMS ARE FOR ADULTS ONLY, AND A CENTER MORICHES LIBRARY CARD IS REQUIRED, UNLESS ADVERTISED AS "ALL ARE WELCOME".

Saturday registration: Lines start forming before 9:30AM for the most popular programs, so it is advisable to arrive up to an hour early in order to secure a spot for yourself. If the weather is bad, we will not have you standing on line outdoors. A security guard will let people inside the building to wait, **in the order that they arrived to stand on line**, and numbers will be handed out.

Due to popularity, some programs may fill within the first hour of registration.

As a young man, working in a lawyer's office, he was given a subscription to a circulating library, which he said was "the signal event of my life up to that time." As a newspaper editor he became friends of Poe and William Cullen Bryant, interviewed P.T. Barnum, was inspired by Margaret Fuller. He was a nurse in the Civil War, an editor in New Orleans and then Camden, N.J., a clerk in Washington D.C., all the while working on Leaves of Grass and other poetry. **B WHITMAN**

All Long Island is irrevocably bound and affected by ecological controls meant to tame such events as Hurricane Sandy. Chapter 9 highlights Robert Moses and his concern for preservation of the wetlands. This history of building, filling in and changing natural wet lands is analyzed, and the author says, "There must be a less rigid developmental approach to life on the edge of the ocean."

Coleman, Reed Farrel. What You Break, c2017.

Gritty story of Gus, a retired Suffolk County cop, his friends, Bill, the retired priest and Slav, the mysterious Russian who saved his life once and the gang life on Long Island.
