DO YOU GO TO WEBBY'S BEACH?

Get your Town of Brookhaven Parking Permit at the Library starting Saturday and Sunday, January 20th and 21st. Permits will be available at Forge River Marina thereafter beginning in May.

The price of the sticker is \$10 until mid-May when it increases to \$15.00. The price for a Senior Citizen (60+), Handicapped and Veterans Sticker is \$5.00.

Residents will need their vehicle, vehicle registration and license when purchasing the permit. Owners of vehicles that are registered out of town or have a PO box must present their tax bill or original utility bill.

PROGRAMS ARE FOR ADULTS ONLY, AND A CENTER MORICHES LIBRARY CARD IS REQUIRED, UNLESS ADVERTISED AS "ALL ARE WELCOME".

Saturday registration: Lines start forming before 9:30AM for the most popular programs, so it is advisable to arrive up to an hour early in order to secure a spot for yourself. If the weather is bad, we will not have you standing on line outdoors. A security guard will let people inside the building to wait, **in the order that they arrived to stand on line**, and numbers will be handed out.

Due to popularity, some programs may fill within the first hour of registration.

Registration online begins at 9:30AM.

Patrons may register **only one** additional cardholder when presenting all library cards at registration. Photocopies of library cards are acceptable, provided the photocopy shows the library card's barcode.

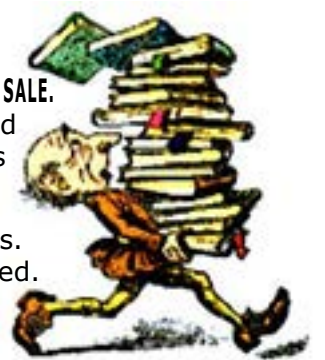
