Aveyard, V. **Red Queen**

Bardugo, L. **Six of Crows**

Criminal prodigy Kaz is offered the chance to pull off the heist of a lifetime. He pulls together a dream team of skilled friends who can help him, only to find that the stakes are higher than he ever thought – the fate of the world may be at stake.

Black, H. **The Cruel Prince**

Jude was seven years old when her parents were murdered and she and her two sisters were stolen away to live in the treacherous High Court of Faerie. Ten years later, Jude wants to belong there, despite her mortality. But many of the fey despise humans. Especially Prince Cardan, the youngest and wickedest son of the High King. To win a place at the Court, she must defy him and face the consequences. In doing so, she becomes embroiled in palace

intrigues and deceptions, discovering her own capacity for bloodshed. As civil war threatens, Jude will need to risk her life in a dangerous alliance to save her sisters, and Faerie itself.

Carson, R. **The Girl of Fire and Thorns**

The younger of two princesses, Elisa has never done anything remarkable. But on her sixteenth birthday, she has become the secret wife of a handsome and worldly king—a king whose country is in turmoil. A king who needs the chosen one, not a failure of a princess.

Clare, C. **City of Bones**

Fifteen year old Clary witnesses a murder at a club, and is pulled into the world of the Shadowhunters, warriors who are dedicated to ridding the earth of demons. The fight becomes personal when her mother is kidnapped and Clary joins the Shadowhunters to find her.

Fisher, C. **Incarceron**

Incarceron is a futuristic prison where the descendents of the original prisoners still live, torn apart by savagery. But Finn, a young prisoner, has memories of a different life. He manages to meet Claudia, who lives outside the walls inside a prison of a different sort, about to be forced into marriage and together, the two plot Finn's escape.
