




The Passion of Dolssa


Code Talker


Deadly


Elliott, L. Annie,


The Night Diary

both – the daughter of a Hindu father and a Muslim mother. When her family become refugees, will the journey end with Nisha finally finding her way home?


Iturbe, A. The Librarian of Auschwitz


Perez, A. Out of Darkness



Naomi and Wash meet in East Texas in 1937, well aware of the racial tensions that divide their town. But their attraction is instant, and could cause an explosion, like the one that will


hit the local white school...
