In this program you will learn that there are hundreds of ingredients in a cigarette, and when burned, thousands of toxic chemicals are created that are well known to be hazardous to your health. After the 3rd week, smoking cessation medications including nicotine replacements Zyban or Chantix will be provided for an annual fee of \$50 to medically eligible participants.
