LIBRARY BUDGET VOTE TUESDAY, APRIL 18TH, 2017.

Residents of the Center Moriches Union Free School District are asked to vote on the Library's budget on April 18th, 2:00-9:00pm in the Children's Activity Room. A public hearing on the proposed Library budget will be held in Meeting Room A on Monday, April 3rd at 7:00pm. Copies of the proposed budget for the Library's 2017-18 fiscal year will be available at the Circulation Desk two weeks before the voting date.

Residents of the contracting school districts East Moriches, Eastport-South Manor, and Remsenburg-Speonk will be asked to vote on their Library Proposition on Tuesday, May 16th at the polling places and times for their respective school district budget votes.

Please note! The Annual Library Proposition for East Moriches, Eastport-South Manor, and Remsenburg-Speonk is to determine whether residents of these contracting districts desire public library service to their communities for the upcoming fiscal year, from a choice of public libraries serving their respective districts. If you reside in one of these contracting districts, it is very important that you vote on your Annual Library Proposition.

AUTO RENEWAL SERVICE

This new feature provides Library patrons an added level of convenience by automatically renewing any eligible items three days before they are due. If an item has been renewed too many times, if you have accrued too many fines, or another patron has a hold on the item, the renewal will not be processed. Instead, a Courtesy Notice will remind you to return the items.

To sign up for the service, log into your account and look for the "Sign Up for Auto Renew" link. Once registered for the service you can expect that the system will attempt to renew your checked out items three days before they are due. Once an item is renewed, you will receive an email confirmation.






SATURDAY, APRIL 22, 2017 ST. JOSEPH'S COLLEGE IN PATCHOGUE, 10:00AM-3:00PM

PROGRAMS ARE FOR ADULTS ONLY, AND A CENTER MORICHES LIBRARY CARD IS REQUIRED, UNLESS ADVERTISED AS "ALL ARE WELCOME".

Saturday registration: Lines start forming before 9:30AM for the most popular programs, so it is advisable to arrive up to an hour early in order to secure a spot for yourself. If the weather is bad, we will not have you standing on line outdoors. A security guard will let people inside the building to wait, **in the order that they arrived to stand on line**, and numbers will be handed out.

Due to popularity, some programs may fill within the first hour of registration.

Registration online begins at 10 AM.

Patrons may register **only one** additional cardholder when presenting all library cards at registration. Photocopies of library cards are acceptable, provided the photocopy shows the library card's bar code.



ABC BOATING COURSE saturday, april 22nd, 9:30-5:00pm.

The United States Power and Sail Squadron, Moriches Bay, is offering America's Boating Course (ABC). People completing the course and passing the end of course test will be given a boating safety certificate which satisfies New York State Safe Boating Education require-

ments. Persons born after May 1, 1996 are required to possess this certificate when operating a power boat. All persons regardless of age must complete a Boating Safety Course in order to operate a personal watercraft (Jet Ski/Wave Runner). However, operators of all boats, encouraged to take the course.

The course includes basic boating nomenclature, rules of the "road", Federal and State requirements, and is for all boaters, novice to experienced.

Students that join the Moriches Bay squadron will be offered on the water training with a fellow squadron member at no cost. This training review can be conducted on the student's boat or another squadron member's boat of similar type. This is a great way to get comfortable with pre-launch procedures, boat operation, docking, and safety and emergency procedures.
