

- · New York State Drivers License or New York State issued Non-Drivers ID card with your current street address. If you do not have either of these items that's not a problem just bring with you a form of photo ID and (2) different items from the following list with your name and a physical street address:
- · Current post marked mail.
- · Current utility, cable, water or telephone bill.
- Automobile registration or insurance card.
- Current tax bill, property deed, lease or mortgage state-

Library Journal 5 Star Library

Center Moriches Free Public Library is among 1 of 5 libraries in Suffolk County to have received a 5 Star rating from Library Journal, the oldest



and most respected publication in the field. Of the 257 Star Libraries, only 85 libraries in the country received a five star rating nationally. Library Journal star ratings are based on each library's number of annual patron visits, circulation, public access computer use, and program attendance. Star Library ratings of five, four, and three stars are awarded to libraries that generate the highest combined per capita outputs among their peers. This data is reported each year by public libraries to their state library agencies and is compiled on a national level by the Institute of Museum and Library Services. We are proud and happy to serve our community!
