Present: Dr. Schlein, Mrs. Foster, Mrs. Bryner, Mr. Privett, Mr. Carmer, and Mr. Donnelly.



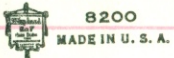
Minutes of the last meeting were approved as read.
