Mr. Carmer will attend the next meeting of the Board of Education to request a District vote on the revised, proposed tax levy. The secretary was instructed to request, by letter, payment of the \$5,000.

New Business

Inasmuch as small repair jobs about the building are in order, it was approved on motion of Mrs. Foster that Mr. Donnelly obtain estimates and arrange to have the repairs made.

On motion of Mrs. Foster, a typewriter table is to be purchased at a cost not to exceed \$30.00.

On motion of Dr. Schlein, the meeting was adjourned at 10:15 p.m.
