Meeting Called to Order: By the President at 8:00 P. M.


Present: Mrs. Havens, Mrs. Davis, Mrs. Goldsmith, Mr. MacDonald

Touch up floor in dining room under corner cabinets which will be removed. Also paint bathrooms 1 coat, and radiators 1 coat.
