

REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES
OF THE CENTER MORICHES FREE PUBLIC LIBRARY
HELD ON OCTOBER 9, 1957 AT THE LIBRARY

Meeting Called to Order: By the President at 8:00 P. M.

Minutes: On motion by Mrs. Goldsmith and seconded by Mr. MacDonald
and animously carried, the minutes of the last meeting were approved

Circulation: The librarian reported the September circulation as
follows: 1957 for 19 days - 924
1956 for 24 days - 866

This marks an increase of 12 books per day the library was opened
with the juvenile circulation far ahead of the adult circulation.

New Business:

1. Mrs. Havens reported that the locks on the doors of the
toilets would be installed soon. Also, the out side light
has now been connected to our side of the building; the cable
in the kitchen has been taken care of.

2. It was reported that the Moriches Rotary Club is interested
in sponsoring a shelf for our library. Mr. Binnington recommended
that instead of a special shelf, the club be asked to select a
particular subject they would like to provide books on and then
from time to time books could be purchased from a fund set up by
the Club. The library would place bookplates in such purchases.
It is suggested that it would be advisable for Mr. MacRobbie,
chairman of this Rotary Committee, to consult with Librarian
Binnington.

3. It was reported that additional shelving cannot be arranged for until the new furniture arrives, because it is necessary to determine how many books the new shelving will hold. The books were audited and found to be in a satisfactory condition.
