
**Acevedo, Elizabeth - Clap When You Land**






### Alsaid, Adi - We Didn't Ask For This


### Anderson, Laurie Halse - Wonder Woman: Tempest Tossed






### **Black, Holly - The Queen of Nothing**


### Chapman, Elsie - Caster

### Emezi, Akwaeke - **Pet**



he'll do anything to keep buried, because as it turns out, he wasn't the only one to have gone missing on that fateful night all those weeks ago.




### **Hahn, Erin - You'd Be Mine**




Izzy and Jules were childhood friends, climbing the spires of Batuu, inventing silly games, and dreaming of adventures they would share one day. Then,

### Yang, Gene Luen - **Superman Smashes the Klan**








