

On Tuesday, September 15 from the hours of 2:00 pm - 8:00 pm the library will be holding its annual Trustee election in the Community Room. Center Moriches School District residents will be



asked to vote for a trustee term that runs from September 16, 2020 until June 30, 2025. Current incumbent is Jacques LeBlanc.

With current circumstances the Board of Trustees decided that the budget will use the same tax appropriation as Fiscal Year 2019-2020 and under State Education Law Section 259 no vote is required.

Curbside and Locker Pickup

Curbside pickup is available Monday-Friday from 11:00 am-7:00 pm and on Saturday from 11:00 am-4:00 pm. Place reserves on items by speaking with a librarian or placing a hold online at, https://search.livebrary. com/search~S8

Once you've been called that your items are ready for pick up, park in one of the desig-

nated curbside spots and call us to let us know you're here. Please have your library card available. We'll bring your items out to your car. Curbside service does not operate in inclement weather.

Additionally, if your prefer, we offer a contactless locker system for pickup. Our holdIT locker system is located at the front of the building and is available 24/7. Once you've been notified, to retrieve your items you'll need your library card and the password associated with your account. After you've entered your information, the locker bay automatically opens for you to retrieve and check out your items.







Unfortunately due to the Covid 19 virus our bus trips are on "PAUSE". Trips will resume as soon as it is safe to travel.






