

#### **COVID-19 Update**

The Library is slowly lifting restrictions. At the time of publication, patrons are welcome to stay in the facility for one hour and we are allowing 30 patrons in at a time. We have added additional seating and ask that you do not move the furniture. Please continue to adhere to social distancing guidelines.

Weather permitting, we continue to offer curbside service Monday-Friday from 11:00 am - 5:00 pm and on Saturday from 11:00 am - 4:00 pm. We also continue to offer 24/7 contactless locker service, faxing, scanning, computer services and photocopying. There are no passport services, in person group meetings or programs currently offered at this time. We are continuing our virtual programming and are pleased to be offering a wide variety of classes for Adults, Teens and Children that can be found in this current edition of the newsletter.

Masks must be worn while at the library. If you've forgotten your mask, please speak to the Security Guard upon entering the library and they will provide you one at no charge. Additional hand hygiene stations are available throughout the library.


