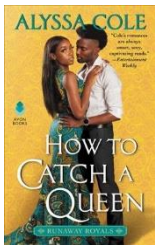


Bellefleur, A. Written in the Stars

Darcy Lowell is desperate to stop her brother from playing matchmaker ever again. Astrologer Elle Jones dreams of

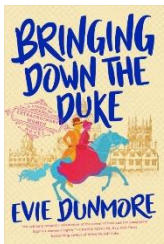

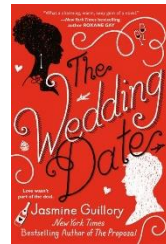


Dunmore, E. Bringing Down the Duke

suffrage. Her target: Sebastian Devereux, the cold and calculating Duke of Montgomery. Her challenge: not to give in to the powerful

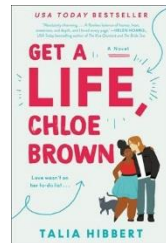
attraction she can't deny for the man who opposes everything she stands for.

Going to a wedding with a guy she gets stuck with in an elevator is something Alexa Monroe wouldn't normally do.

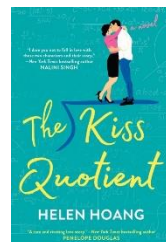

Emerging from a life-threatening illness, a fiercely organized but unfulfilled computer geek recruits a mysterious artist to

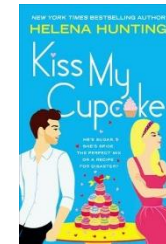
help her establish meaning in her life, before finding herself engaged in reckless but thrilling activities.

When mathematician Stella Lane decides to improve her love life, she hires Michael Phan, an escort, to help her gain

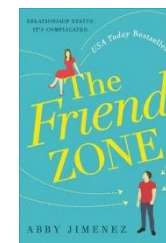
knowledge and experience in dating.

Blaire Calloway has planned every moment of her cupcake and cocktails shop launch to perfection. What she didn't plan

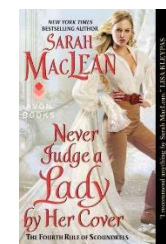

Kristen Peterson has no room in her life for guys who just don't get her. She's also facing a procedure that will make it

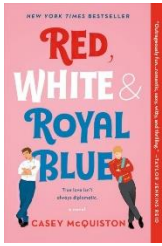

Lady Georgiana's secret identity as Chase, the founder of London's worst gaming hall, is threatened by Duncan West, who

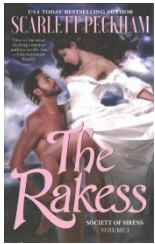
is intrigued by the mysterious beauty and determines to uncover all of her dark secrets.

The book no one can stop talking about! The president's son. The Prince of Wales. Rivals. Enemies. Lovers? Thrown into a fake

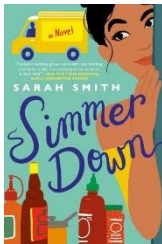
friendship for PR, Alex-Claremont-Diaz and Prince Henry find they might like each other after all, perhaps even as more than just friends...

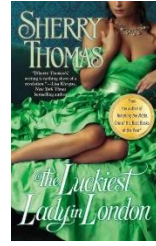

Nikki DiMarco knew life wouldn't be all sunshine and coconuts when she quit her dream job to serve up mouthwatering Filipino dishes

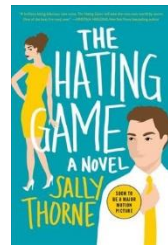
to hungry beach goers, but she didn't expect the Maui food truck scene to be so eat-or-beaten--or the competition to be so smoking hot.

Louisa Cantwell needs to marry well. She does not, however, want Lord Wrenworth.. She mistrusts his outward perfection,

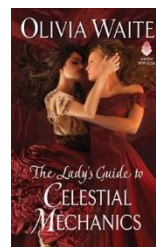
