

If you are a resident of Center Moriches or a contract patron of East Moriches, Eastport-South Manor or Remsenburg-Speonk School Districts and would like to get a new library card or renew an expired one, please bring with you (1) of the following items:

· Valid New York State driver's license or Non-Driver's Photo ID that has your current physical street address. If you do not have the above item, please bring a form of photo ID and

(2) different items from the following list with a physical street address:

- · Current postmarked mail.
- Current utility bill (cable, telephone, water, etc.).
- Automobile registration or automobile insurance card.
- Lease, Property Deed, Tax Bill, Mortgage statement.

Residents under the age of 18 must have a Parent/Guardian present.
