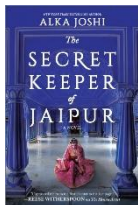
Malibu Rising: a novel

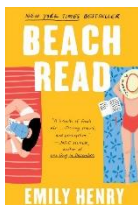
What's Done In Darkness: a novel

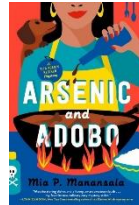
The Secret Keeper of Jaipur: a novel

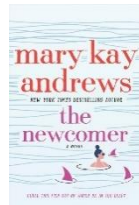
Beach Read
