## Library Card Renewal!

Center Moriches School District residents' library cards are up for renewal as of January 1, 2022. Please come on down to the library and renew your cards. Please make sure when you come to renew or register for your library card bring with you one of the following items:

New York State Driver's License or New York State issued Driver's ID card with your current street address.

If you do not have either of these items please bring a form of photo ID and (2) different items from the following list with your name and a physical street address:

- · Current post marked mail.
- Current utility, cable, water or telephone bill.
- Automobile registration or insurance card.

Current tax bill, property deed, lease or mortgage statement. Residents under the age of 18 must have a Parent/Guardian present.



## **Notary**

The library now offers a Notaries Public service. Any individual wishing to have a document notarized should call the library at 631-878-0940 to see if the Notary is available. There is no fee to use this service.

The Library will be hosting a Blood Drive on Monday, January 31st between the hours of 12:30 - 6:30pm. Your donation will help to save up to THREE lives.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Bring NY Blood Center or alternate ID with name and photo.
- Minimum weight 110 lbs.
- Age 16 75 (16 year olds must have parental permission)
- Age 76 and over (need doctor's note).
- Eat well (low fat) & drink fluids.
- No tattoos for past 12 weeks.





## \*Healthy Libraries and Social Work Intern\*

The Healthy Libraries Program (HeLP) consists of students who are currently training in the fields of social work, public health, library science, and nursing, who are available at the library to provide blood pressure screenings, and to answer questions and provide reliable, evidence based information on a wide variety of health topics such as heart disease, diabetes, understanding medications and much more.

Students are also available to direct patrons to community resources, help fill out paperwork for social services, find housing, and assist with finding a healthcare provider and scheduling appointments.

This program will be available to all community members on February 1st and 15th and March 1st and 22nd from 2:00 pm -4:30 pm.

Additionally, our Social Work Intern is available on Mondays between the hours of 11:00 am - 3:00 pm and Tuesdays between the hours of 11:00 am - 5:00 pm and can assist with emergency clothing and shelter, family matters and food assistance. 


