Narcan Training (In Person)

Learn how to identify signs of an opioid overdose and how to administer intranasal Narcan before EMS arrives. The goal of the class is to shorten the critical time period between discovery of an opioid overdose and administration of Narcan, a life saving antidote. Participants will receive a certificate of completion/authorization card and an emergency resuscitation kit that includes Narcan. - No tattoos for past 12 weeks.
