

Library Cards

If you are a resident of Center Moriches or a contract patron of East Moriches, Eastport-South Manor or Remsenburg-Speonk School Districts and would like to get a new library card or renew an expired one, please bring with you (1) of the following items:

- Valid New York State driver's license or Non-Driver's Photo ID that has your current physical street address.
- If you do not have the above item, please bring a form of photo ID and
- (2) different items from the following list with a physical street address:
- Current postmarked mail.
- Current utility bill (cable, telephone, water, etc.).
- Automobile registration or automobile insurance card.
- Lease, Property Deed, Tax Bill, Mortgage statement. Residents under the age of 18 must have a Parent/Guardian present.

Did you know that your library has online magazines for Children, Teens and Adults? Flipster offers an easy, browseable reading experience. Users can browse magazines by category as well as perform searches for specific periodicals. An online newsstand provides a carousel of the most recent issues, as well as a carousel of all issues allowing for quick access to magazines. The table of contents contains links for quick access to articles of interest and hotlinks within magazines are hyperlinked, opening in separate tabs when clicked. In addition, there is an option to zoom in and out for better readability. Find Flipster on our website at www. centermoricheslibrary.org or ask a Librarian for assistance in getting started! 
