# Healthy Libraries and Social Work Intern The Healthy Libraries Program (HeLP) consists of students who

are currently training in the fields of social work, public health, library science, and nursing, who are



available at the library to provide blood pressure screenings, and to answer questions and provide reliable, evidence based information on a wide variety of health topics such as heart disease, diabetes, understanding medications and much more. Students are also available to direct patrons to community resources, help fill out

paperwork for social services, find housing, and assist with finding a healthcare provider and scheduling appointments. Stony Brook Medicine's Healthy Libraries Program (HeLP) is a partnership with the Public Libraries of Suffolk County, the Suffolk Cooperative Library System Outreach Services Department, and is supported in

part by the American Heart Association of Long Island. The HeLP program will be at our library on November 1st from 2-4:30 pm. No appointment is necessary and all are welcome.

Our Social Work Intern is also available on Tuesdays and Thursdays between 11:00 am – 4:00 pm to assist with emergency shelter, family matters and food assistance. This is not for counseling services. To schedule and appointment






