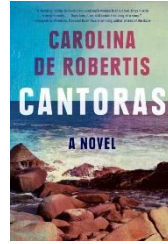
Blake, A. *Delilah Green Doesn't Care*

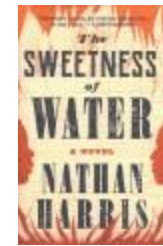
Guns, P. *Your Driver is Waiting*

August doesn't believe in finding the kind of love they make movies about. But then there's Jane, beautiful and impossible. When August

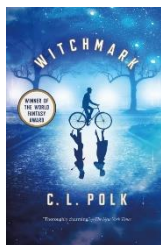
realizes Jane is displaced in time from the 1970s, it might be time to start believing.

Velasin never planned to marry, until an envoy suggests marriage to a prince of the neighboring kingdom. For Caethari, his

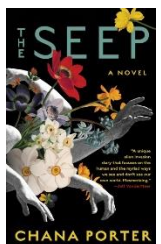
betrothal to a man from Ralia, where such relationships are forbidden, is a shock. With a faction willing to kill to end their new alliance, they have to trust each other.

Miles Singer went to war to escape his destiny, but couldn't leave his past behind. When a fatally poisoned patient exposes Miles' magic, he must risk his

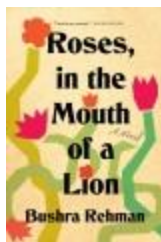
freedom to investigate the murder, and he'll need to rely on the most gorgeous man he's ever seen.

wanting to plan a heist, Kit may be unable to deny whatever this highborn man desires...



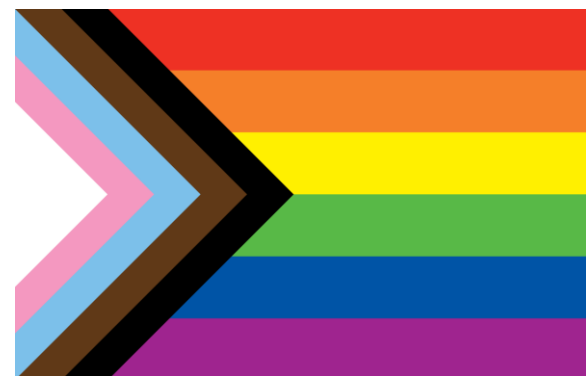
Stuart, D. *Young Mungo*
