Mothers fly away like migrating birds. This is why farmers have daughters. Yet when her mother brings home a six-foot tall crane with a menacing air, the girl is powerless


to prevent her mom letting the intruder into her heart, and her children's lives.


As the chase continues along this road paved with the suffering of angry ghosts, what form will the echoes of their anguish take?






The Angel Maker Alex North

The Silent Companions Laura Purcell


Inside her new home lies a locked door, beyond which is a painted wooden figure--a silent companion-that bears a striking resemblance to Elsie herself. The residents of The

Book of Cold Cases Simone St. James



While clearing out her father's home, artist Haven Marbury finds a secret handwritten manuscript that is disturbingly different from anything else he had written. The


stories unsettle but also entice Haven, practically compelling her to illustrate them while she stays in the house that her father warned her was haunted.
