

is a partnership with the Public Libraries of Suffolk County, the Suffolk Cooperative Library System Outreach Services Department, and is supported




Social Work Intern

Parking Lot Improvements

The Library is excited to announce that in the upcoming year we will be adding additional parking in the recently acquired land adjacent to the library along with a new design of the existing parking lot. Careful budgeting and grant money has allowed this project to proceed without asking the public taxpayer for additional funding for this capital project. Construction will begin later this year and take several months to complete. This expansion will create 55 new parking spaces, widen existing spaces and add additional handicap stalls. 




