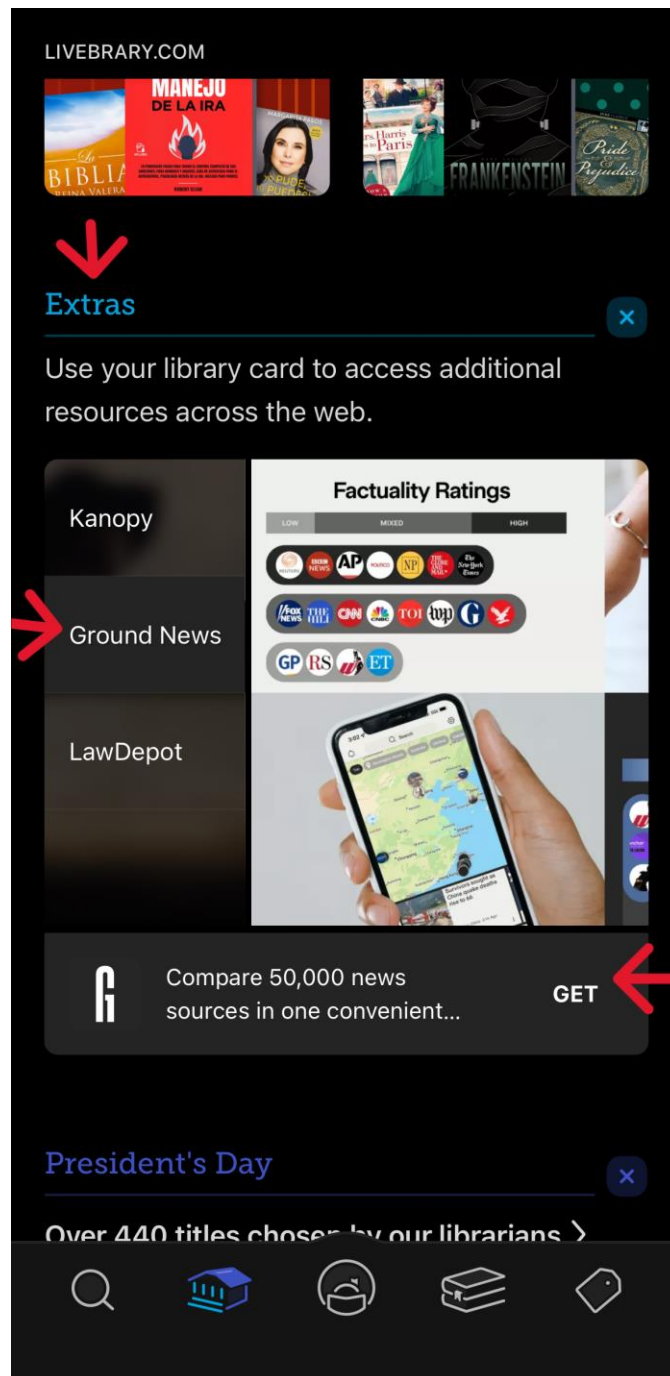


Ground News Quick Start Guide

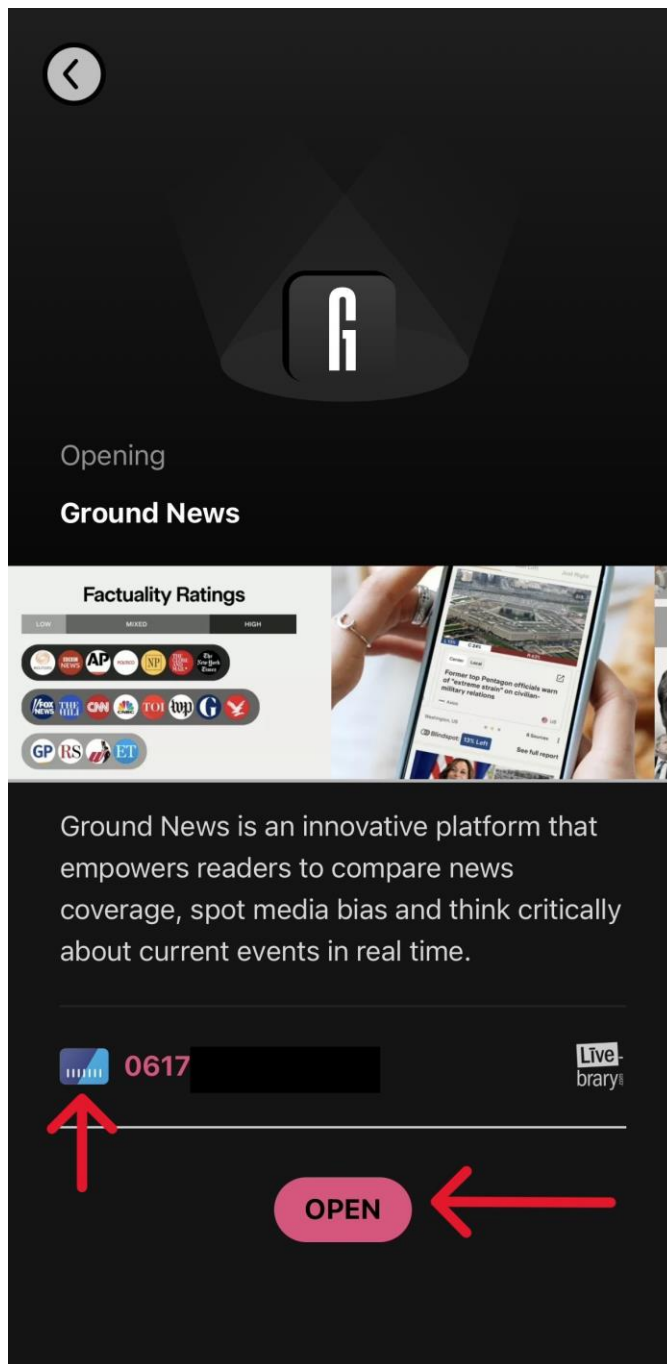


1. Ground News is a new resource offered through Libby which gives readers the ability to compare news sources and merge the same story from multiple different outlets to give readers multiple perspectives in one piece.

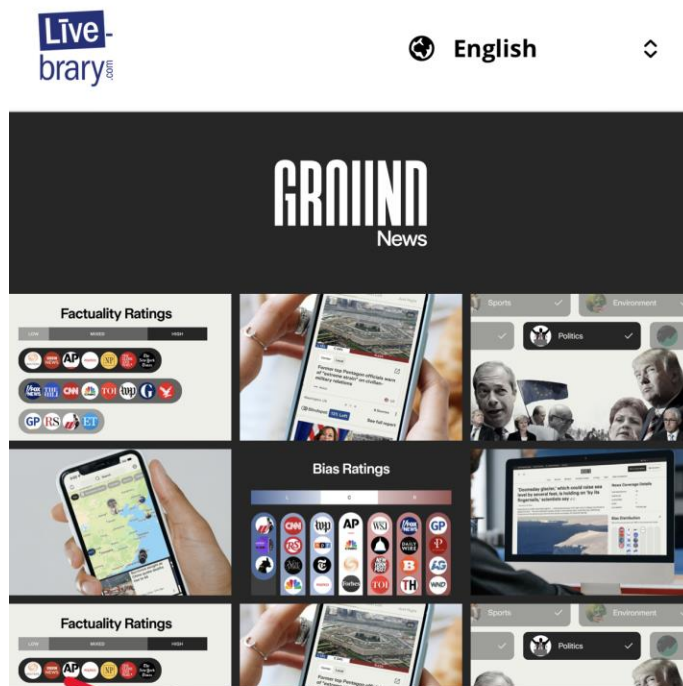
- To get to Ground News open Libby to the home page and scroll down until you see the blue extras tab. Click on the Ground News tab and click 'GET' on the lower right-hand side.



- From there it will verify your library card number and have you click the open button.



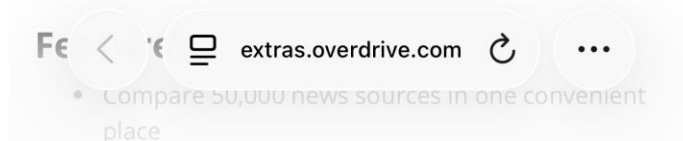
4. The app will open a webpage in your browser and take you to the 'Get Access' screen where you will hit the 'get access' button.



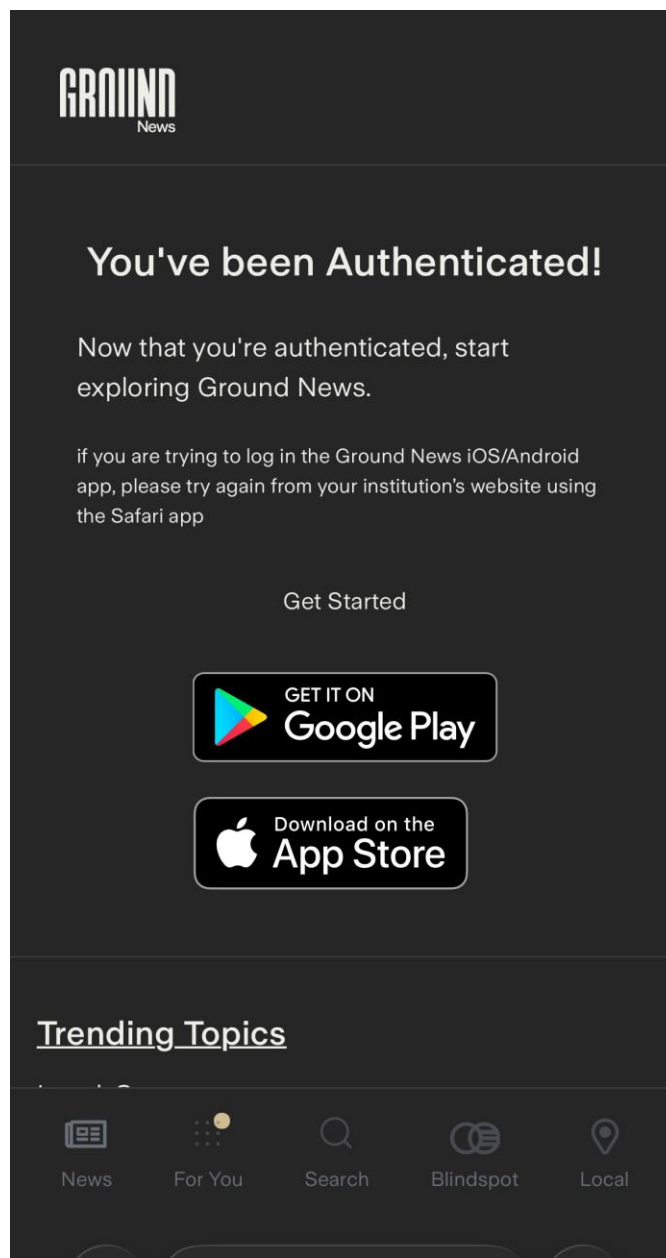
You'll have full access to content from Ground News for 30 days. When it expires, you can get access through Libby again.

Some content may include mature themes and language.

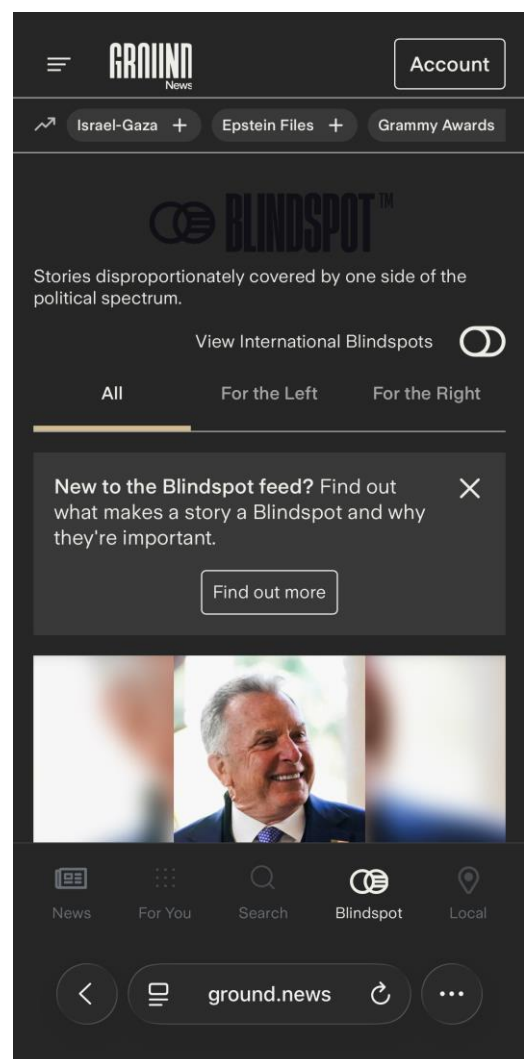
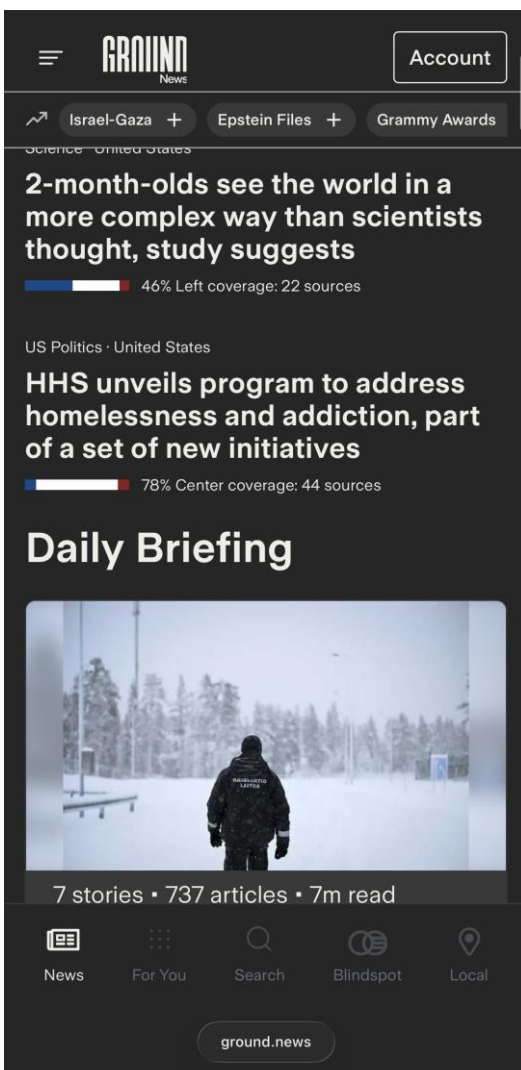
Ground News is an innovative platform that empowers readers to compare news coverage, spot media bias and think critically about current events in real time.
