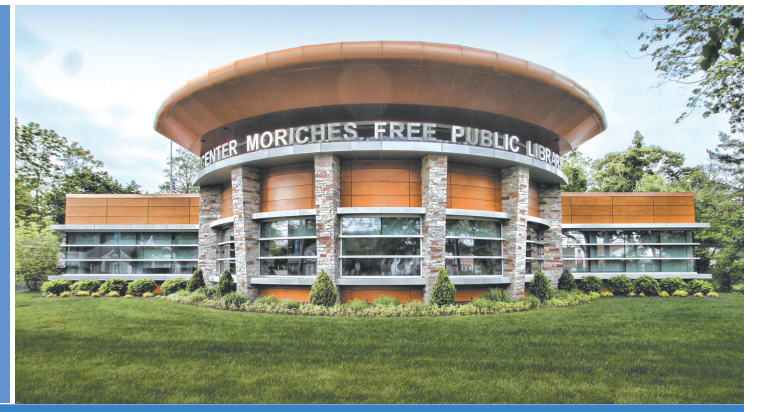

CONTRACT DISTRICT LIBRARY CARDS

If you are a contract patron of East Moriches, Eastport-South Manor or Remsenburg-Speonk School Districts and would like to get a new library card or renew an expired one, please bring with you (1) of the following items:

- Valid New York State driver's license or Non-Driver's Photo ID that has your current physical street address. If you do not have the above item, please bring a form of photo ID and (2) different items from the following list with a physical street address:
 - Current postmarked mail
 - Current utility bill (cable, telephone, water, etc.)
- Automobile registration or automobile insurance card
- Lease, Property Deed, Tax Bill, Mortgage statement
- Voter registration card
- Children under the age of 18 must have a Parent/Guardian signature.

For Contract Patrons, the following guidelines have been established to help us serve you better.

- You may select the library of your choice beginning July 1 each contract year. The "home library" cannot be changed during the course of the contract year (July 1 – June 30)
- All members of the same household must register at the same library
- A contract card is good for one year (July 1-June 30)
- Cardholders may use the services of all other Suffolk County public libraries. Some services in other libraries may be restricted
- New registrations and renewals can be made in person or online at Livebrary.com/ContractDistricts or scanning the QR code with your phone.

Unless otherwise stated, Registration is **Saturday, June 13th at 9:00 am**. DUE TO THE POPULARITY OF THE FOLLOWING CLASSES, programs are for adults only (16 years and above), and a Center Moriches Library Card is required, unless advertised as "All Suffolk County Library Cardholders Welcome". **Registration begins for MOST Monthly Events on Saturday, April 18th at 9:00 am** and must be done online on

our website at www.centermoricheslibrary.org, or in person. Click on Programs & Events and choose "Library Calendar". There is also a tab with directions on how to register online for programs. If you are going to be absent for a program that you are registered for, please call the Adult Department so that someone on the waiting list may be called.

Some programs are offered as both in-person and Zoom/YouTube classes. With the exception of exercise programs, we ask that you choose between taking it in person or online (not both)
